BUNNY BOARDING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Note: **BUNNY BOARDING** is hereafter referred to as “the company”. The owner of the pet(s) to be boarded is hereafter referred to as “the owner”. The boarding pet(s) is hereafter referred to as “the boarder”.

1. The company accepts to provide:-
 - a. The appropriate foods and fresh water daily.
 - b. The appropriate living conditions
 - c. The appropriate standards of cleanliness.
 - d. To minimise the risk and spread of disease and ill health.
2. To assist with 1.d.(above), the company will undertake a visual inspection of the boarder upon arrival. No pet suspected to be, or suffering from, any infectious or contagious disease can be accepted for general boarding, pending advice from our Veterinary Surgeon.
3. The company will not allow contact between boarders at any time, unless they come as a pair or social group together.
4. Proof of vaccination for rabbit boarders is preferred as recommended by the Rabbit Welfare Association.
5. The company may require the boarder to be fleaed, mited and wormed where this is thought to be necessary.
6. Wherever possible the owner should provide the boarders’ own familiar, escape-proof housing, to minimise stress to the boarder. However, hutches are provided for rabbits and guinea-pigs.
7. The company ask for full and honest details relating to the boarder and any of their special dietary, social, behavioural or special requirements.
8. The company will require, and the owner accepts to provide, full owner

details, date of return, proof of identification by means of a driving licence, passport or credit card.

9. The owner accepts that methods of payment to the company will be by Cash or cheque.
10. The owner accepts that should the company feel that the boarder requires veterinary attention, then the company will use its regular veterinary practice (unless the owner has stated a preference) and the veterinary bills will be reimbursed in full by the owner upon collection of the boarder at the end of its stay, including an accompany charge.
11. The owner accepts that accident, injury, illness, death, theft, public liability and all other insurances for the owner and the boarder whilst visiting and boarding with the company are the responsibility of the owner and that the company is released from all such liabilities.
12. The owner accepts that there are no existing licensing laws or regulations in respect of boarding rabbits and rodents of a non-dangerous kind.
13. The owner accepts that if the boarder is not collected within 14 days after the agreed collection date and that the owner cannot be contacted by the company and the owner has failed to contact the company to arrange an extension to the agreed boarding dates, the company will deem this to be "abandonment" by the owner. The boarder will then become the property of the company who will seek to suitably re-home the boarder.
14. The owner accepts these full Terms and Conditions.
